Public hearing, discussion, consideration and final action on Ordinance no. 17-005, an ordinance amending chapters 2, 11, 14, 15, 18, 22, 26, 32 and 34, Of the code of ordinances of the Village, relating to boards, Commissions and Committees; providing for their composition and selection of their members; establishing by ordinance certain advisory boards, commissions and committees formerly established by resolution; and amending other details Regarding such boards, commissions and committees

NEW BUSINESS:

11. Approval of Resolution no. 17-025, A resolution requiring the prompt securing of the premises and residence to abate an immediate menace to the public comfort, health, peace and safety at 100 coyote run, being lot 10 of the Bonnie Addition Subdivision within section 15, t.12n, r.3e, n.m.p.m., in the Village of Corrales, Sandoval County, New Mexico (the "property"); requiring the owner or owners of the property promptly to commence and complete the securing of the property against entry and the removal from the property of all ruined, damaged and dilapidated materials, including but not limited to construction of a secure fence surrounding the residence and any other structures on the property, effectively protecting against unauthorized entry; providing that the owner, occupant or agent in charge of the property may file written objections to this resolution and seek a hearing before the Governing Body of the Village of Corrales in accordance with statute; authorizing the administration of the Village of Corrales to cause the securing, abatement or removal of the ruined, damaged and dilapidated materials if the owner or owners of the property do not timely undertake such actions; providing that the Village of Corrales shall recover its costs incurred for securing, abatement or removal of the ruined, damaged and dilapidated materials as and to the extent provided by statute.
12. Discussion and approval of Reorganization of Planning and Zoning Department to Community Development Team, to include updated job descriptions for Community Development Coordinator (CDC) and Compliance-Enforcement Officer (EO).

13. Approval of Resolution no. 17-026, A Resolution Relating to Runoff and Drainage in the Salida del Sol Subdivision, Phase II; Authorizing Closing of an Existing Drainage Structure across Camino Rayo del Sol and Construction of a New Drainage Structure in a Different Location to Accommodate Development on Lots 110 and 115 of the Subdivision.
14. Discussion and consideration to publish and post Ordinance no.17-007, An Ordinance relating to the home occupation permits in the A-1, A-2 and H rural agricultural, residential and historical zones of the Village; Proving that certain professional services conducted from the home do not require a home occupation permit; Allowing up to three employees in home occupations in all parts of the Village; Provide for the sale of a home occupation in conjunction with the home, without need for a new home occupation permit.


