

**VILLAGE OF CORRALES
ORDINANCE NO. 06-12**



**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2, ADMINISTRATION;
ARTICLE II, MAYOR AND GOVERNING BODY; SECTION
2-60(D), AGENDA; OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR
THE VILLAGE OF CORRALES**

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the Village of Corrales, New Mexico, that:

Section 2-60 (D) of the Code of Ordinances, Village of Corrales is hereby amended to read as follows:

(d) *Agenda.* All reports, communications, ordinances, resolutions, contracts, documents, or other matters to be submitted to the Governing Body shall be delivered to the village clerk at least six calendar days prior to each meeting, whereupon the clerk shall immediately arrange a list of such matters according to the order of business. Each councilor, the Mayor and the village attorney will be furnished with a Draft Agenda. The information packet will be complete and available to the Governing Body five (5) calendar days prior to the regularly scheduled Council meeting. Items may be added to the Draft agenda after that date only if they are required to be acted upon by that Council meeting and must be placed on the agenda at least twenty-four (24) hours before the meeting. In such cases, all members will be notified by telephone or in person. Under the agenda item New Business a Councilor, by motion, may propose that an issue be placed on a future Council agenda for discussion and/or action.

Additional items can be added at the time of the meeting for discussion only by majority of the Governing Body.


SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. Should any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this ordinance, for any reason, be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity and unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this ordinance. The Governing Body of the Village of Corrales hereby declares it would have passed this Ordinance and each section, subsection, sentence, clause, word, or phrase thereof irrespective of anyone or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses, words, or phrases being declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid.

COMPILING CLAUSE. This ordinance shall be incorporated in and compiled as a part of the Code of Ordinances, Village of Corrales.


EFFECTIVE DATE AND PUBLICATION. This ordinance shall become effective and be in full force and effect from and after its passage, publication and posting, according to law.
