



VILLAGE OF CORRALES

ORDINANCE NO. 09-012

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TO THREE DOLLARS (\$3.00) THE AMOUNT OF THE JUDICIAL EDUCATION FEE COLLECTED BY THE MUNICIPAL COURT.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 35-14-11, NMSA 1978, as amended and supplemented through the 2009 New Mexico regular legislative session, every municipality is required to adopt an ordinance requiring the assessment and collection of certain fees, including judicial education fees, by the municipal court; and

WHEREAS, 2009 New Mexico Laws Chapter 245 (House Bill 263) adopted by the New Mexico legislature at its 2009 regular session provides that the amount of the judicial education fee shall be three dollars (\$3.00); and

WHEREAS, the amount of the judicial education fee as set by the legislature is mandatory for all municipal courts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the Village of Corrales, New Mexico, that:

Section 1. The amount of the judicial education fee as set forth in Subsection 1-6(b)(2) and in Subsection 34-2(2) of the Code of Ordinances of the Village of Corrales is amended in each instance to read “three dollars (\$3.00)” in place of “two dollars (\$2.00).”

Section 2. Except as specifically amended herein, the provisions of Section 1-6 of the Village Code (being Ordinance No. 244, adopted March 10, 1992, as subsequently amended) and of Section 34-2 of the Village code (being Ordinance No. 353, adopted October 22, 2002, as subsequently amended) are not changed or affected by this Ordinance and remain in full force and effect.


SEVERABILITY CLAUSE: Should any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance. The Governing Body of the Village of Corrales hereby declares that it would have passed this Ordinance and each section, subsection, sentence, clause, word or phrase thereof irrespective of any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses, words or phrases being declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid.

COMPILING CLAUSE: This Ordinance shall be incorporated in and compiled as a part of the Code of Ordinances of the Village of Corrales, as herein set forth.

EFFECTIVE DATE AND PUBLICATION: This Ordinance shall become effective and be in full force and effect from and after its passage, publication and posting, according to law.


