



VILLAGE OF CORRALES ORDINANCE NO. 09-016

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING CHAPTER 20, LAW ENFORCEMENT; ARTICLE IV, POLICE RESERVE CORPS; OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE VILLAGE OF CORRALES.

WHEREAS, the Governing Body desires to remove surplus language from its Code of Ordinances which serves no useful purpose in the current and future conduct of government responsibilities and activities within the Village of Corrales; and

WHEREAS, Article IV of Chapter 20 provides for a Police Reserve Corps to assist in the keeping of the peace and public safety, though no citizen has been designated to serve in the Corps by the Chief of Police or has served in such a capacity within the past fifteen years; and

WHEREAS, the Corrales Police Department is a fully trained and certified professional law enforcement agency without need of an auxiliary Reserve Corps; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Corrales through intergovernmental agreements and memoranda of understanding contributes to and receives, as needed, assistance from the New Mexico State Police, the Sandoval and Bernalillo County Sheriff's Departments, the Albuquerque and Rio Rancho Police Departments, the Drug Enforcement Agency and other neighboring and regional law enforcement agencies;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the Village of Corrales, New Mexico, that:

Article IV of the Code of Ordinances, Village of Corrales is hereby amended by repealing the entire existing Article IV, thereby eliminating it from Chapter 20, Law Enforcement; Article IV, Police Reserve Corps, of the Code of Ordinances for the Village of Corrales.


SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. Should any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this ordinance, for any reason, be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity and unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this ordinance. The Governing Body of the Village of Corrales hereby declares it would have passed this Ordinance and each section, subsection, sentence, clause, word, or phrase thereof irrespective of anyone or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses, words, or phrases being declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid.

COMPILING CLAUSE. This ordinance shall be incorporated in and compiled as a part of the Code of Ordinances, Village of Corrales.


EFFECTIVE DATE AND PUBLICATION. This ordinance shall become effective and be in full force and effect from and after its passage, publication and posting, according to law.
