



VILLAGE OF CORRALES

ORDINANCE NO. 15-03

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 347, ADOPTED JULY 9, 2002; REPEALING RESTRICTIONS ON TURNS AT THE INTERSECTIONS OF PASEO TOMAS MONTOYA WITH CAREY ROAD AND WITH MIKAELA ROAD.

WHEREAS, on July 9, 2002, the Village Council, the governing body (“Governing Body”) of the Village of Corrales, New Mexico (the “Village”) adopted Ordinance No. 347, amending Ordinance No. 243 and adopting and incorporating by reference the Far Northwest Sector Plan of the Village; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 347 amended the Village’s Northwest Sector Plan to include turning restrictions providing that traffic from Paseo Tomas Montoya would not be permitted to proceed southbound on Carey Road or Mikaela Road at the intersections of Paseo Tomas Montoya with those roads, and also restricting the directions in which northbound traffic on Carey Road or Mikaela Road would be permitted to turn at Paseo Tomas Montoya; and

WHEREAS, after twelve years of experience with the flow of traffic in the Far Northwest Sector and adjacent areas of the Village, the Governing Body finds that there is no compelling reason to prohibit or restrict the turning movements that were prohibited by Ordinance No. 347 at the intersections of Paseo Tomas Montoya with Carey Road and Mikaela Road; and

WHEREAS, it has been brought to the attention of the Governing Body that the said prohibitions on turning movements result in inconvenience and delay for local residents seeking to access their residences from Paseo Tomas Montoya.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the Village of Corrales, New Mexico, that:

1. That part of Ordinance No. 347 relating to turning movements at the intersections of Paseo Tomas Montoya with Carey Road and Mikaela Road, beginning with the words “PASEO TOMAS MONTOYA” at page 2, line 5 of that Ordinance and ending with the words “. . . westbound on Paseo Tomas Montoya” at page 2, line 17 of that Ordinance, is REPEALED.

2. The Village’s Northwest Sector Plan is hereby AMENDED by deletion of the passage cited in the foregoing Section 1, where that passage appears within the section headed “ROAD DESIGN GUIDELINES” of the Northwest Sector Plan.


3. Except to the extent specifically repealed or amended by this Ordinance or by prior ordinances adopted by the Governing Body, all provisions of Ordinance No. 347 and the Far Northwest Sector Plan remain in full force and effect.

SEVERABILITY CLAUSE: If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance is held to be unconstitutional, invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance. The Governing Body of the Village of Corrales hereby declares that it would have passed this Ordinance and each section, subsection, sentence, clause, word or phrase thereof irrespective of any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses, words or phrases being declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid.

EFFECTIVE DATE AND PUBLICATION: This Ordinance shall become effective and be in full force and effect, from and after its passage, publication and posting, according to law.


