



VILLAGE OF CORRALES

ORDINANCE NO. 16-03

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO VILLAGE LAWS; ADOPTING AND ORDAINING A REVISED AND AMENDED CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE VILLAGE OF CORRALES; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ANY INCONSISTENT PROVISIONS OF PRIOR ORDINANCES; PROVIDING A GENERAL PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF ORDINANCES AND THE VILLAGE CODE.

WHEREAS, the Village Clerk has caused to be prepared and has presented to the Village Council, the governing body (“Governing Body”) of the Village of Corrales (the “Village”), a revision of the Code of Ordinances (the “Village Code”) of the Village, reflecting new ordinances adopted, ordinances repealed, and amendments to various ordinances and Village Code provisions since adoption of the last revision of the Village Code in 2007; and

WHEREAS, the 2016 revision of the Village Code presented to the Governing Body also includes many non-substantive amendments and corrections to the materials contained in the 2007 Village Code, as well as updated and revised finding aids, cross-references, and references to State of New Mexico laws and regulations; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body finds that the “Code of Ordinances 2016” as presented to the Governing Body by the Village Clerk should be adopted as the Code of Ordinances of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the Village of Corrales, New Mexico, that:

Section 1. This ordinance adopts for the Village of Corrales a code of ordinances entitled “Code of Ordinances 2016,” hereinafter referred to as the “Village Code,” which is to be considered as a new and original comprehensive ordinance, as compiled, consolidated, codified and indexed, which shall supersede any and all ordinances passed by the Governing Body on or before the adoption date of this Ordinance, but only to the extent that such ordinances are inconsistent with the Village Code as hereby adopted.

Section 2. All ordinances of a general and permanent nature adopted prior to the effective date of this Ordinance, and not contained in the Village Code or recognized and continued in force by reference therein, are repealed only to the extent of any inconsistency with the provisions contained in the Village Code. However, the repeal provided herein shall not be

construed to revive any ordinance or portion thereof that has been repealed by a subsequent ordinance which is repealed, in whole or in part, by this Ordinance.

Section 3. Any and all additions and amendments to the Village Code, when passed in such form as to indicate the intention of the Governing Body to make the same a part thereof, shall be deemed to be incorporated in the Village Code so that the reference to the Village Code herein shall be understood and intended to include such additions and amendments.

Section 4. A copy of the Village Code in electronic form shall be kept on file in the office of the Village Clerk, and shall be made available to the public on the Village web site. In addition, copies printed on paper may be made and preserved in loose-leaf form, or in such other form as the Village Clerk may deem most expedient. It is the duty of the Village Clerk to insert in their designated places all amendments or ordinances which indicate the intention of the Governing Body to make the same a part of the Village Code, and to extract from the Village Code all provisions which may from time to time be repealed or replaced by action of the Governing Body. A copy of the Village Code in either electronic or paper form shall be available for any person desiring to examine the Village Code during normal working hours. Copies of the Village Code, or any portion thereof, may be purchased from the Village Clerk at a reasonable fee determined by the Village Clerk for the cost or reproduction, in accordance with the New Mexico Inspection of Public Records Act, Sections 14-2-1 et seq., NMSA 1978.

Section 5. It shall be unlawful for any person to change or amend, by additions or deletions, any part or portion of the Village Code, or to insert or delete pages, or to alter or tamper with the Village Code in any manner whatsoever which will cause the laws of the Village to be misrepresented. Any person violating this section shall be punished as provided in Section 3 of this Ordinance.


Section 6. The Village Code as adopted herein shall hereafter be received without further proof in all courts of competent jurisdiction and administrative tribunals of the State of New Mexico and the agencies and political subdivisions thereof as the ordinances of a general and permanent nature of the Village.

SEVERABILITY CLAUSE: Should any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance. The Governing Body of the Village of Corrales hereby declares that it would have passed this Ordinance and each section, subsection, sentence, clause, word or phrase thereof irrespective of any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses, words or phrases being declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid.

EFFECTIVE DATE AND PUBLICATION: This Ordinance shall become effective and be in full force and effect from and after its passage, publication and posting, according to law.
