



VILLAGE OF CORRALES

ORDINANCE NO. 16-06

**AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE LICENSING OF ANIMALS;
AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 249, ADOPTED NOVEMBER 24, 1992;
PROVIDING FOR LICENSING OF DOGS AND CATS FOR A PERIOD OF TIME
NOT EXTENDING BEYOND THE ANIMAL'S CURRENT RABIES VACCINATION;
PROVIDING THAT LICENSE AND TAG FEES WILL BE SET BY RESOLUTION.**

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 249, adopted November 24, 1992, the Village of Corrales (the "Village") has provided for the licensure and issuance of tags for dogs, cats and exotic animals, and set the fees for such licensure and tags; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council, the governing body of the Village ("Governing Body") finds that the period for which license may be issued, as set forth in Ordinance No. 249, should be clarified and options should be provided for licenses valid for multiple years, but not extending beyond the period during which the animal's rabies vaccination remains current; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body finds that license fees should be set by resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the Village of Corrales, New Mexico, that Ordinance No. 249, Section 4, as codified at Section 6-4 of the Code of Ordinances of the Village (the "Code"), is amended as follows:

Section 1. Subsection 6-4(e)(2) of the Code is amended to read as follows:

- (2) The license shall contain the information required in Subsection (c)(1) of this section. Licenses and tags may be issued for a period of up to three (3) years, but shall in any event expire no later than the expiration date of the current rabies vaccination.

Section 2. Subsection 6-4(f) of the Code is amended to read, in its entirety, as follows:

- (f) *Fees.* The fees for scheduled licenses and tags under this chapter shall be as determined from time to time by resolution of the Governing Body.


SEVERABILITY CLAUSE: Should any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance. The Governing Body of the Village of Corrales hereby declares that it would have passed this Ordinance and each section, subsection, sentence, clause, word or phrase thereof irrespective of any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses, words or phrases being declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid.

COMPILING CLAUSE: The amended subsections of the Village Code adopted pursuant to this Ordinance shall be compiled as a part of the Code of Ordinances of the Village of Corrales, as provided herein.

EFFECTIVE DATE AND PUBLICATION: This Ordinance shall become effective and be in full force and effect from and after its passage, publication and posting, according to law.


