### Resolution 12-043

#### **A Resolution to Establish a Water Issues Advisory Committee**

**Whereas**, by Resolution 10-063, adopted December 21, 2010, the Governing Body created a Water Advisory Board to present general recommendations on , among other matters, the availability of water to the Corrales community for agricultural and domestic purposes, water conservation, municipal uses and practices, and other water issues; and

**Whereas**, at its meeting July 17, 2012, the Governing Body received the report of the Water Advisory Board; and

**Whereas**, among the Board's recommendations, it called for creation of a standing committee on water issues to monitor changes to the water laws and meet periodically, particularly before sessions of the New Mexico legislature, to monitor and advise the Governing Body on proposed statutory and regulatory changes affecting Corrales.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Governing Body of the Village of Corrales:**

1. That a Water Issues Advisory Committee is hereby established.
2. That the Committee shall consist of three to five members including, as available, individuals with expertise and knowledge in water law, water policy, agriculture, and related activities.
3. That the Committee, upon formation, will meet at the call of the Chair as needed to monitor proposed changes to the statutes and regulations affecting water use in New Mexico, inform the Governing Body and the Corrales community, and recommend appropriate responses from the Governing Body.
