**A Resolution to Establish the Safe Routes to School Team
to make recommendations regarding citizen educational activities to
promote bicycle and pedestrian safety.**

Whereas, a Safe Routes to School Team was established to comply with the Phase I grant with New Mexico- SRTS; and

Whereas, the Governing Body, on June 23, 2009, accepted the Action Plan as a conceptual guideline for future funding requests and general activities; and

Whereas, Corrales residents, Corrales Elementary students, and Cottonwood Montessori students benefit from the activities performed by the SRTS Team; and

Whereas, the Village of Corrales is committed to promoting bicycle and pedestrian safety, bicycling and walking as alternative transportation modes, and the health benefits of cycling and walking.


Now, therefore, be it resolved by the Governing Body of the Village of Corrales, New Mexico that:

1. A Safe Routes to School Team consisting of at least 5 members shall be appointed to serve as a standing advisory committee to the Governing Body and provide citizens with educational activities which promote bicycle and pedestrian safety for students.
2. SRTS team members shall include a staff representative of each partner school, a parent or PTA member, a public health or recreational professional and such others nominated by the Mayor and approved by the Village Council who will contribute to the purposes for which the SRTS Team was established.
3. The SRTS may solicit and receive grants, donations and monies which upon receipt shall be deposited in a Special Fund administered by the Village and made available for lawful purposes identified by the SRTS Team.
4. The SRTS team shall meet monthly, or as needed, and will comply with the State of New Mexico Open Meetings Act requirements.

5. The SRTS team shall submit to the Village Clerk minutes of each meeting which shall be included in the monthly Consent Agenda.


