



VILLAGE OF CORRALES

RESOLUTION NO. 13-034

A resolution identifying a partnership between the Village of Corrales and Corrales Main Street, Inc. to apply to the New Mexico Economic Development Department to create a Corrales State Authorized Arts and Cultural District

Whereas, the Governing Body wishes to pursue a “State Authorized Arts & Cultural District (ACD)” as authorized by the New Mexico Arts and Cultural District Act of 2007; and

Whereas, a Request for Applications has been issued by the Economic Development Department’s State Arts and Cultural District Coordinator with a deadline for response by September 13, 2013; and

Whereas, two new communities are to be selected as Start-Up ACDs this fall, joining Las Vegas, Silver City, Downtown Albuquerque, Los Alamos, Raton and Taos in this economic development program; and

Whereas, the authorizing agency making the selections is the New Mexico Arts Commission of the Department of Cultural Affairs; and

Whereas, the application will identify a partnership among the Village, Corrales MainStreet, Inc., with the Corrales Cultural Arts Council as a supporting organization; and

Whereas, program requirements include formation of an initial Steering Committee of 7 to 11 members including two official representatives of the Village; and

Whereas, the Steering Committee will work on an ACD Cultural and an ACD Master Plan to be adopted by the Village; and

Whereas, the State Authorized ACD program contemplates that a paid staff person, working at least 20 hours a week, be employed to coordinate the work of the Steering Committee and ACD District; and

Whereas, State Authorized ACD program benefits include assistance from the State’s Coordinator in developing: appropriate Cultural and Master Plans, an Arts and Cultural Section to a Local Economic Development Plan (LEDA), and Statewide branding efforts; and


Whereas, in communities with State Authorized ACD programs, commercial property owners are eligible for a doubling of historic property tax credits (to \$50,000) and access to the NM Historic Preservation Loan Fund,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the **Governing Body of the Village of Corrales** that it:

- 1. Supports the submittal of an application to the New Mexico Economic Development Department for a State Authorized Arts & Cultural District in coordination with Corrales MainStreet, Inc. and the Corrales Cultural Arts Council, and
- 2. Appoints the Village Administrator and the Planning & Zoning Administrator to the initial Steering Committee for a Start Up Corrales Arts and Cultural District.
