



## VILLAGE OF CORRALES RESOLUTION NO. 13-045

### CALLING FOR A REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON MARCH 4, 2014 IN THE VILLAGE OF CORRALES:

#### BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE VILLAGE OF CORRALES:

Section 1. A regular municipal election for the election of municipal officers shall be held on March 4, 2014. Polls will open at 7:00 A.M. and close at 7:00 P.M.

Section 2. At the regular municipal election, persons will be elected to fill the following elective offices:

Section 3. The following question(s) shall be submitted at the regular municipal election:

1. Whether the Village of Corrales should issue a General Obligation bond in the amount of \$500,000 to establish a wastewater utility revolving loan fund to assist property owners in connecting to the installed wastewater collection line in the high density service area along Corrales Road between Wagner Lane and Meadowlark Lane and to provide a fund for future improvements of, and connections to, the wastewater utility system? YES NO
2. Whether the Village of Corrales should issue a General Obligation bond in the amount of \$1,500,000 to expand existing wastewater utility service and plan, design, and construct collection lines to the immediate needs areas where lots of less than  $\frac{3}{4}$  acres are to be served? YES NO

Section 4. In accordance with NMSA 1978 §3-8-10, the following districts are consolidated for the regular municipal election:

CD01: Consists of districts 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6

Section 5. The following locations are designated as the polling places for the conduct of the regular municipal election.

Voting Convenience Center: Corrales Recreation Center, 500 Jones Road (all districts)

Absentee and Early Voting: Office of the Village Clerk, 4324 Corrales Road

Section 6. All Declarations of Candidacy shall be filed with the Municipal Clerk on Tuesday, January 7, 2014 between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 5:00 P.M.

Section 7. All Declarations of Write in Candidacy shall be filed with the Municipal Clerk on Tuesday, January 14, 2014 between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 5:00 P.M.

Section 8. Persons desiring to vote in this election must register with the Sandoval County Clerk not later than 5:00 PM on February 4, 2014, the date on which the County Clerk will close registration books.

Section 9. Absentee Voting. Applications for absentee ballots may be obtained only from the office of the Municipal Clerk. All applications for an absentee ballot must be completed and accepted by the Municipal Clerk prior to 5:00 p.m., February 28, 2014. After 5:00 p.m. on February 28, 2014, all unused absentee ballots will be publicly destroyed by the Municipal Clerk. The Municipal Clerk will accept completed absentee ballots delivered by mail, or in person by the voter casting the absentee ballot, by a member of the voter's immediate family, or by the caregiver to the voter until 7:00 p.m. on March 4, 2014.


Absentee ballots may be marked in person in the office of the Municipal Clerk during the regular hours and days of business, beginning on Tuesday, January 28, and closing at 5:00 p.m. on Friday, February 28, 2014.

Early Voting. Early voting on paper ballots counted by M100 electronic vote tabulator will be conducted in the office of the Municipal Clerk during the regular hours and days of business, beginning on Wednesday, February 12, 2014 and closing at 5:00 p.m. on Friday, February 28, 2014.

Section 10. The casting of votes by qualified municipal electors shall be recorded on paper ballots to be counted by M100 electronic vote tabulators.
