



## VILLAGE OF CORRALES STATE OF NEW MEXICO

### EMERGENCY DECLARATION

**Declaring an Emergency/Disaster for the Village of Corrales;  
Authorizing Appropriations and Acceptance of Aid in Accordance with the All Hazard  
Emergency Management Act.**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Corrales (the "Village"), within Sandoval County, is suffering severe damage caused by flash flooding because of heavy rain, which began on the 11th day of September, 2013 and impacted the Village on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of September 2013,

**WHEREAS**, extensive damage was caused to public and private property, streets, roads, bridges, water, power and other facilities in the Village; and,

**WHEREAS**, the damage has resulted in undue human suffering and hardship and threatens the safety, health, welfare, and well-being of citizens and effective economic function of the Village of Corrales; and,

**WHEREAS**, all locally available public and private resources and forces available to mitigate and alleviate the damage are deemed insufficient to cope with the resulting situation, initiate and complete repairs, and meet restoration requirements;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, by virtue of the authority provided by the New Mexico All Hazard Emergency Management Act (NMSA 1978, Sections 2-10-01 to 12-10-104) do hereby declare the Village of Corrales, within Sandoval County, to be a disaster area for the purpose of exercising necessary emergency powers and expenditure of available resources, and requesting aid, assistance, and relief programs and funds available from the State of New Mexico and other sources. I am explicitly authorized to make appropriations and accept aid for the purposes set forth herein in accordance with Section 12-10-7, NMSA 1978, and all other applicable laws and ordinances of the Village, the State of New Mexico, and the United States.
