RESOLUTION NO. 15-03

A Resolution to Establish the Trails Master Plan Task Force to review and make recommendations to implement The Master Trails Plan.

Whereas, The purpose of the Trails Master Plan is to develop specific goals and objectives for the implementation of a Village-wide trails network. It includes a map of the existing and future trail routes, as well as a framework for executing the trail development objectives, and a ten year development prioritization list.

Whereas, in order to facilitate consistent and informed management of the Village Trails System, The Village of Corrales proposes to assemble a Master Trails Plan Task Force.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Governing Body of the Village of Corrales:

1. That the task force shall review the Master Trails Plan;
2. That the task force shall consist of; Members from within the Village of Corrales and should include representatives from the Village administration, and Village Trails advocacy groups, such as the Equestrian Advisory Board (EAC), Safe Routes to School(SRTS), Corrales Bosque Advisory Commission (CBAC), The Corrales Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee (CBPAC), Parks and Recreation Commission, and MainStreet.
3. That the task force will meet monthly, or as needed, and comply with the Open Meetings Act.
4. That the Task Force will keep minutes of its meetings which will be distributed to the Governing Body and available to the public.
5. That the Task Force will prepare a report for presentation to the Governing Body no later than May 4, 2015, with its recommendations on how to implement the plan, and with improvements or changes that the Task Force would recommend.
