**A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF AN EXTENSION OF THE 2012 MUNICIPAL
ARTERIAL PROGRAM MAP-7643(906) CONTROL # L300060 IN ORDER TO
COMPLETE THE PROJECT WITH AMENDED DESIGN**

Whereas, on September 17, 2012 the Village of Corrales received an agreement for project funding of \$280,000 from the New Mexico Department of Transportation Municipal Arterial Program to eliminate chronic flooding of NM448 at the intersections of Corrales and West and East Ella Roads; and

Whereas, on October 25, 2012 the Village of Corrales tasked our on call engineer The Larkin Group for engineering services for the same project; and

Whereas, on July 30 2013 the Village of Corrales entered into a License Agreement with the Middle Rio Grande Conservancy District for a buried utility parallel at the Corrales Interior Drain at East Ella Road ; and

Whereas, the Village Council in order to accommodate developing concerns needs to amend the redesigned project and does not foresee sufficient time for response and approval of permitting.


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Governing Body of the Village of Corrales, that:

Dear Rick,

The Village of Corrales is requesting a one-year time extension for the above referenced project. In 2012 after ten years of planning with Sandoval County, Middle Rio Grande Conservation District and the NM Department of Transportation, the Village of Corrales was awarded \$ 280,000 for a; Municipal Arterial Project funding to eliminate a chronic flooding of NM448 at the intersections of East and West Ella with Corrales road.

The extended grant agreement for this project expires June 30, 2015. Due to complications involved in redesigning the project to accommodate area concerns and the environmental clearance required with the new design the other permission, the project has again been delayed.

The additional work has delayed the amended license from the Middle Rio Grande Conservancy District which will be further delayed by the preferred construction date after the irrigation season in October. We also need permits with NMDOT District3 for structures on NM448 to start construction. The Village of Corrales has completed the tasks for correcting West Ella but has not been able to start the work needed on East Ella and will not be able to complete the project without the grant funding being extended. Enclosed is a resolution adopted by the governing body at regular meeting April 28, 2015.
