RESOLUTION NO. 16-16

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING FEES FOR ANIMAL LICENSES AND TAGS.

WHEREAS, the Village Council, the governing body (“Governing Body”) of the Village of Corrales (the “Village”) has adopted Ordinance No. 16-06 (the “Ordinance”), Amending Ordinance No. 249, adopted November 24, 1992 and relating to animal licenses and tags; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 16-06 provides that fees for licenses and tags shall be set by resolution of the Governing Body.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE VILLAGE OF CORRALES that fees for animal licenses and tags shall be as follows:

1. Annual license and tag fees, for each animal and for each year or portion thereof that the license is effective:

Dogs, unneutered	\$25.00
Cats, unneutered.....	\$25.00
Dogs, neutered	\$4.00
Cats, neutered.....	\$4.00
Hobby breeder.....	\$35.00
Exotic animals.....	\$5.00

2. The annual license and tag fee levied on senior citizens shall be \$2.00 for each neutered dog or cat. To qualify as a senior citizen, the applicant must present proof of age and be 55 years of age or older.
