**A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF AN EXTENSION OF THE 2016 MUNICIPAL
ARTERIAL PROGRAM MAP-7601(914) CONTROL #L300147 IN ORDER TO
COMPLETE WEST MEADOWLARK PROJECT; MATCHING FEDERAL FUNDS STP
(A301460) AND TAP (A300472).**

Whereas, on August 19, 2015 the village of Corrales received an executed agreement for project funding of \$313,333 from the New Mexico Department of Transportation Municipal Arterial Program to plan, design, construction reconstruct, pavement rehabilitation, drainage and miscellaneous improvements for on West Meadowlark roadway and equestrian/bicycle trails; and


Whereas, on January 10, 2017 the Village of Corrales awarded the Weston Solution engineering firm tasked with designing the West Meadowlark roadway and equestrian/bicycle trails.

Whereas, the Village Council in order to accommodate developing concerns needs to complete the West Meadowlark project matching funds to the federal STP (A301460) and TAP (300472).


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Governing Body of the Village of Corrales, that:
