**A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING "SIPHON ROAD" AS THE NAME FOR THE
ACCESS ROAD AT THE NORTH END OF THE CORRALES BOSQUE AT THE
BOUNDRY OF THE VILLAGE OF CORRALES AND THE CITY OF RIO RANCHO
ON A
PROPERTY OF THE MIDDLE RIO GRANDE CONSERVANCY DISTRICT**

WHEREAS, the Village of Corrales, New Mexico and the Middle Rio Grande Conservancy District have interest in an official name of the access road for safety purposes; and

WHEREAS, the said Access road has many visitors to parking and river entry and has had calls for public safety assistance that require an address for inclusion in the E911 system and the region emergency dispatch center; and

WHEREAS, the MRGCD has the capability of maintaining Siphon Road in an appropriate manner, as the Village assigns road names and addresses within the Village boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body finds that, for the foregoing reasons, the Village should name the current MRGCD access road located at the Corrales Siphon on the west bank of the Rio Grande to Corrales Road (NM428).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE VILLAGE OF CORRALES, THAT:

1. The MRGCD Access road at the north end of the Village of Corrales and the Corrales Bosque preserve between the river and Corrales will be named Siphon Road.
