



VILLAGE OF CORRALES RESOLUTION NO. 17- 042

**CALLING FOR A REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON MARCH 6,
2018 IN THE VILLAGE OF CORRALES:**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE VILLAGE OF CORRALES:

Section 1. A regular municipal election for the election of municipal officers shall be held on March 6, 2018. Polls will open at 7:00 A.M. and close at 7:00 P.M.

Section 2. At the regular municipal election, persons will be elected to fill the following elective offices:

At Large	One Mayor	4 year term
District 1	One councilor	4 year term
District 3	One councilor	4 year term
District 4	One councilor	4 year term

Section 3. The following question(s) shall be submitted at the regular municipal election:

1. Shall the Village of Corrales impose a 1/8th of 1 percent increase in the Municipal Infrastructure Gross Receipt Tax pursuant to ordinance duly adopted and Section 7-19D-18, NMSA 1978, and pledge the proceeds therefrom to support the issuance of up to \$1,000,000 in revenue bonds to acquire, design, construct, reconstruct, rehabilitate, and landscape municipal streets and roads, trails, bikeways, walkways, bridges and associated drainage structures throughout the Village?
2. Shall the Village of Corrales issue up to \$500,000 in general obligation bonds payable from general (*ad valorem*) taxes to acquire, construct, equip, renovate, and improve public buildings in the Village of Corrales?
3. Shall the Village of Corrales issue up to \$1,500,000 in general obligation bonds payable from general (*ad valorem*) taxes to acquire, design, construct, equip, renovate, improve and landscape fire and public safety facilities for fire suppression and emergency response, and to acquire vehicles, apparatus and equipment for the fire and police departments of the Village of Corrales?
4. Shall the Village of Corrales issue up to \$2,500,000 in general obligation bonds payable from general (*ad valorem*) taxes for the purpose of acquiring conservation easements or other rights or interests in land for the preservation of farmland, open space, wildlife habitat, and recreational opportunities?

Section 4. In accordance with NMSA 1978 §3-8-10, the following districts are consolidated for the regular municipal election:

CD01: Consists of districts 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6

Section 5. The following locations are designated as the polling places for the conduct of the regular municipal election.

Voting Convenience Center: Corrales Recreation Center, 500 Jones Road (all districts)

Absentee and Early Voting: Office of the Village Clerk, 4324 Corrales Road

Section 6. All Declarations of Candidacy shall be filed with the Municipal Clerk on Tuesday, January 9, 2018 between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 5:00 P.M.

Section 7. All Declarations of Write in Candidacy shall be filed with the Municipal Clerk on Tuesday, January 16, 2018 between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 5:00 P.M.

Section 8. Persons desiring to vote in this election must register with the Sandoval County Clerk not later than 5:00 PM on February 6, 2018, the date on which the County Clerk will close registration books.

Section 9. Absentee Voting. Applications for absentee ballots may be obtained only from the office of the Municipal Clerk. All applications for an absentee ballot must be completed and accepted by the Municipal Clerk prior to 5:00 p.m., March 2, 2018. After 5:00 p.m. on March 2, 2018, all unused absentee ballots will be publicly destroyed by the Municipal Clerk. The Municipal Clerk will accept completed absentee ballots delivered by mail, or in person by the voter casting the absentee ballot, by a member of the voter's immediate family, or by the caregiver to the voter until 7:00 p.m. on March 6, 2018.


Absentee ballots may be marked in person in the office of the Municipal Clerk during the regular hours and days of business, beginning on Tuesday, January 26th, and closing at 5:00 p.m. on Friday, February 26, 2018.

Early Voting. Early voting on paper ballots counted by Image Cast Evolution (ICE) electronic vote tabulator will be conducted in the office of the Municipal Clerk during the regular hours and days of business, beginning on Wednesday, February 14th, 2018 and closing at 5:00 p.m. on Friday, March 2, 2018.

Section 10. The casting of votes by qualified municipal electors shall be recorded on paper ballots to be counted by Image Cast Evolution (ICE) electronic vote tabulators.


